

Blue Sky Daycare Covid 19 Health Policy

To Families bringing your child/children to daycare, I would like to ask you please do the following:

- Please remain outside during drop off and pick up, text me before picking up so I can get your child/children ready to go home
- Please limit your child's exposure to other people, don't bring your child to the grocery store or visit other families for playdates if you are not sure about practicing appropriate social distancing
- Wash your child/children hands before drop off and after pick up
- Do Not send your child to daycare if your child has any sickness and/or Covid-19 symptoms
- If your child has any of these symptoms like runny nose, fever, cough please keep her/him home until they have been assessed by a health care provider to exclude Covid-19 or other infectious diseases, AND their symptoms have resolved. Infection prevention and control measures can help create a safe environment for children and us.
- I will check for those symptoms with you every day
- If a child shows symptoms at the daycare, I will contact the parents or authorized person to pick up the sick child and, in the meantime, I will keep her/him in a quiet room separate from others.

- Please dress up your child properly due to the weather as we will spend lots of time outdoors to practice safe social distancing.

I will do my best to practice and teach social distancing between the children, but we really are like an extension of your family in regard to contact so what you expose your child outside the daycare, will impact myself and the other families in the daycare.

I will be increasing the cleaning, hand washing and sanitization that already occurs in the daycare as well. I will also put away toys that are difficult to clean.
